Banana Pikelets



Ingredients

- 2 cups self-raising flour
- 1/4 cup caster sugar
- 50g butter, melted and cooled
- 2 eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 ½ cups milk
- 2 bananas, mashed
- Extra butter for cooking

Method

In a medium bowl, sift the flour and mix in the sugar. Whisk in the butter, eggs and milk until a smooth batter forms. Stir in the mashed banana. Heat a frying pan over

medium heat and let some butter melt on the surface. Place spoonful of the batter into the frying pan. Cook until bubbles form on top and flip and cook through.
