RECYCLING AT LONSDALE HEIGHTS SCHOOL

We have recently received a grant to install extra recycling bins in the classrooms. These bins will be used for refundable drink containers and soft plastics. The students will be educated about recycling these products and classes will be allocated to do collections and organise for items to get to their correct recycling centre. Some students will use these collections for maths lessons, i.e. counting in 10's, sorting and weighing the soft plastics which normally would go into landfill. Lonsdale Heights School also recycles paper and cardboard, batteries and ink cartridges along with general kerbside recycling with the Council. If you wish to recycle these from home you are welcome to bring them in to put with our recycling. Each class has a set of bins for soft plastic and drink containers.

Reconciliation Week is the week beginning 28th May, 2018. Lonsdale Heights School will be having an activities event on Wednesday 30th May where students will move around the school to other classes and be involved in Reconciliation day celebrations. We will also be having a whole school sausage sizzle and drink.

As you may be aware a number of students from grades 3 to 7 are rehearsing for this year's Rock Musical called "Timeweaver". We first performed this way back in 2010. The students involved have already learnt the dance routines and we have now blocked the whole show. The hard work of remembering lines; songs and dance routines is now the focus.
