Challenge of Practice

Goals

If we incorporate book base learning across our preschool we will improve children's ability to gain meaning when engaging with print and visual texts

Success Criteria

Children will be freely engaging in a hands on approach to book base literacy learning throughout the year, both individually, with peers or as a group (with an educator/adult).

Families will be utilising our Literacy Take Home Packs at home with their children.

Children will be able to see themselves as 'bookmakers' and/or 'authors'.

Children will be incorporating Story Baskets into their play episodes. Children's level of involvement in Book Base Literacy Activities will have increased as measured by data from RRR (Involvement Scale).

To support children's ability to quantify their world through the use of the standard number system

If we utilise a Whole site (P-2) approach to understanding mathematical language, specifically number strategies, then we will support all children's understanding of the standard number system.

Children's level of involvement in number sense will have increased as measured by data from the involvement scale of RRR and analysis of observations.

Families are engaging with our Numeracy Take Home Packs. A Co-designed (P-2) Number Sense Program that ensures a continuity of learning from the Preschool Numeracy Indicators and Foundation-2 Number and Algebra Content Descriptors (Australian Curriculum).
